

Stedina għal Impenn fil-Komunità ta' Hajja Nisranija

L-impenn fil-Komunità ta' Hajja Nisranija għandna nifmuh bħala twegiba ta' mħabba lil Alla li jhobbna, u li impenja ruħu għalina sa mill-bidu. Għalhekk huwa impenn fuq kolloxx għal Alla, għal hajja ta' fedeltà lejha, mibnija fuq il-valuri tal-Vangelu, permezz tal-istil ta' hajja tal-KHN imfissra fil-Prinċipji Ġenerali.

Għaliex tajjeb li nimpenja ruħi b'mod formali?

- Bħala bnedmin għandna bżonn sinjali tangibbli li jsaħħuna fl-ghazliet importanti tagħna. Meta nesprimi l-impenn tiegħi quddiem il-Komunità tisaħħah ir-rieda tiegħi; dan jgħini nibqa' fidil għall-ghazla tiegħi fi żminijiet ta' dgħufija.
- Meta nimpenja ruħi, insaħħah il-komunità li jiena nħobb, u fejn jiena kbirt. Il-komunità issa taf li tista' torbot fuqi, li noffri, skont kif nista', il-hin u r-riżorsi tiegħi, u b'hekk tikber u tisaħħah bħala Komunità Apostolika. Fl-istess hin, meta nimpenja ruħi b'mod pubbliku, il-membri tal-komunità jkunx xhieda, u jidhlu għar-responsabbiltà li jgħinuni f'dan l-impenn.

Xi għajjuniet f'din għazla:

- Din hi għazla personali u ma għandiex tiddependi fuq dak li jiddeciedu shabek fil-komunità.
- Aghmel dan il-pass biss jekk għalik jagħmel sens, u jekk hu xi haga li tixtieq, u thoss li ser tgħinhekk tikber fl-imhabba.
- Aghmel dan il-pass wara li taqsam il-hsieb tiegħek mal-komunità, jew mal-'guide', u tisma' dak li jaħsbu huma. Itlob flimkien mal-komunità dwar l-ghazla tiegħek. Dan jgħin ukoll lil-membri l-oħra biex jerfgħu r-risponsabbiltà li jgħinuk twettaq dan l-impenn.
- Biex nidhol għal dan l-impenn jehtieg li nkun naf sew fiex tikkonsisti l-istil ta' hajja tal-Komunità ta' Hajja Nisranija, mhux biss b'moħħi, izda wkoll għax digà qieghed/qieghda ngħixha, ukoll jekk b'mod limitat.

Hawn taħt jidhru xi kriterji dwar x'wiehed jistenna minn xi hadd li jidhol għal impenn inizjali, biex jgħinuk fl-ghazla tiegħek:

- Relazzjoni hajja ma' Alla li tesprima ruħha konkretament fit-talb ta' kuljum, fit-tfittxija regolari tas-Sagramenti, u fil-prattika regolari tal-*Examen*, li jagħti dawl fuq kif Alla jahdem f'hajti.
- Bidu ta' esperjenza fl-Eżercizzi Spiritwali f'forma ta' irtiri fis-skiet. (Dawk li għadhom ma għamlux l-Eżercizzi Spiritwali ta' San Injazju b'mod shiħ għandu jkollhom xewqa ġenwina li jagħmluhom u jimpenjaw ruħhom li dan isir fi żmien tlett snin.)
- Sensitività għall-problemi ta' ingustizzja, faqar u kull forma ta' marginalizzazzjoni soċjali, u tfittxija sinċiera għal forom ta' solidarjetà reali mal-vittmi tagħhom. Din is-sensitività tesprima ruħha wkoll fl-ghazliet dwar stil ta' hajja, l-użu tal-hin, u fir-relazzjonijiet fuq ix-xogħol, fil-familja, u fil-hin liberu.
- Sehem fil-hajja tal-komunità, kemm dik lokali kif ukoll nazzjonali u internazzjonali. Fil-prattika dan isehh billi nerfa' sehem mir-risponsabbiltà għall-komunità, billi niddedika hin u/jew riżorsi biex il-komunità tkompli tikber f'kull aspett u tilhaq l-għanijiet tagħha. Dan jinkludi sehem attiv fi proġetti apostoliċi li l-komunità tista' tidhol għalihom minn żmien għal żmien, skond il-possibiltajiet li wiehed ikollu, permezz ta' partċipazzjoni diretta jew b'modi oħra (per eżempju sostenn finanzjarju tal-proġett).

An invitation to commitment in the Christian Life Community

Commitment in the Christian Life Community is to be understood as a loving response to God who loves us, and was committed to us from the beginning. Therefore, the commitment is primarily to God, to a life of faith, based on the values of the Gospel, through the CLC Way of Life embodied in the General Principles.

Why a formal commitment?

- Because we are human, we need tangible signs to sustain us in our important choices. Expressing my commitment before the whole community strengthens my resolve and helps me to remain faithful to my choice in difficult times.
- When I commit myself I strengthen the community which I love and where I have grown. The community knows that I can be depended upon, as far as my circumstances allow, to give of my time and resources that it may grow as an Apostolic Community. At the same time, when I commit myself publicly, the members of the community are witnesses and take on the responsibility of supporting me in my commitment.

Some hints about deciding on commitment

- This is a personal choice, and should not depend on the decision taken by others in your community.
- Take this step only if it makes sense to you, and if it is something you desire and feel will help you grow in love.
- Take this step after having shared your inclinations with your community, or with the guide, and listened to their feedback. Ask the community to pray for you and with you as you make the choice: this will also help the other members to take on the responsibility of supporting you in your commitment.
- Making this commitment obviously requires that I understand the CLC way of Life, not simply with my mind, but especially through having lived it over a period of time, even if in a limited manner.

What qualities would one expect in someone who makes an initial commitment in CLC? Below is a set of criteria which can help you in your decision:

- A living relationship with God which expresses itself concretely in daily prayer, an appreciation of, and regular participation in the sacraments, and regular practice of the Examen which sheds light on how God is working in my life.
- An initial experience of Spiritual Exercises in the form of silent retreats. (Those who have not made the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius in full should have a sincere desire and a commitment to do so within the next three years.)
- Sensitivity to situations of injustice, poverty and all forms of social marginalization, together with a sincere search for concrete ways of showing solidarity with their victims. This sensitivity expresses itself also in my choices of lifestyle, use of free time, and in how I relate to others in my family, at work and other social activities.
- An active participation in the life of the community, at local, national and international levels. This expresses itself concretely by sharing, in some way, the responsibility for the community, dedicating time and/or resources so that it continues to grow and achieves its aims. This includes an active participation in any apostolic projects undertaken by the community, either through direct participation or through other means (eg financial support of the project).
